The Gregory A. Hendel Lifetime Volunteer Service Award

The Hendel Award is intended to honor direct support of community activities and indirect support provided through leadership roles in the business community.

Their dedicated members work on various projects at both the DeVilbiss Scout Reservation and the Pioneer Scout Reservation renovating and building facilities for Scouts and Scouters to use and enjoy. Their first project was finishing the Shower House (1996), and repairing the screens on the Ford Center at Camp Miakonda. The summer of '99 they replaced the bridge leading from the Ford Center to the Museum.

Over the years several trips have been made to the Pioneer Scout Reservation to help get Camp Frontier ready for the summer camping season. One member spent a lot of time working at Pioneer making screen doors for the Dining Hall, Handicraft Cabin, Headquarters Building and doing general repairs. The Camp Engineers have repaired about 100 cots from Pioneer. They were brought down from the Scout Reservation and repaired at Camp Miakonda.

Important Changes To Youth Protection Training Policies

To increase awareness of this problem and to create even greater barriers to abuse than already exist today in Scouting, the Boy Scouts of America is implementing several important changes to further enhance its Youth Protection policies.

Effective June 1, 2010:

- Youth Protection training is required for all registered volunteers.
- New leaders are required to take Youth Protection training before they submit an application for registration. The certificate of completion for this training must be submitted at the time application is made and before volunteer service with youth begins.

- Youth Protection training must be taken every two years. If a volunteer's Youth Protection training record is not current at the time of recharter, the volunteer will not be reregistered.

You can log onto to MyScouting and take the training. Be sure to have your member ID number from your membership card available. Or log in to MyScouting and create an account. You can also access OnLine Youth Protection Training from the council website www.erieshorescouncil.org under Resources/Leader Resources or Training/General Training.
