Camp Miakonda is a multi-use facility which serves both the Boy Scouts of America and the community at large year round. Effective **June 1, 2010** all cabins, sites and facilities at Camp Miakonda must be reserved through the Camp Program Secretary (Nancy). She is the official registrar for all facilities at Camp Miakonda. Unless a site/facility is officially reserved through the Council Camping Secretary, including payment of the required site/facility deposit, the site/facility should be considered as NOT reserved. All Scouting units and non-Scouting groups should contact the Council Camp Program Secretary directly to reserve a site/facility at Camp Miakonda.

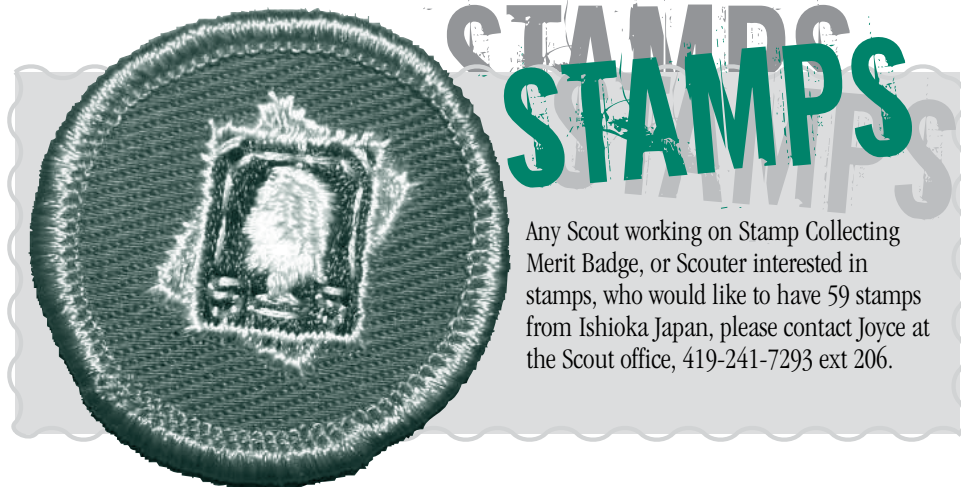
All reservations for Camp Miakonda facilities must have ½ the rental fee paid as deposit at the time the reservation is made with the balance paid in full three (3) weeks prior to the event. Reservations not paid at that time are considered unreserved and available. If under 3 weeks, all fees must be paid at the time the reservation is made. Reservations not paid in full on the designated due date are subject to immediate cancellation. You will be sent a permit when your fees are paid in full in advance of your reservation. This permit must be shown for cabin/site access and to check into camp.

## Medical Forms

Don't forget!!! You and your Scouts need to be using the NEW Medical forms #34605. They are available at the Scout offices and on the council website [www.erieshorescouncil.org](http://www.erieshorescouncil.org) under "Leader Resources". Youth and adults use the same form. This new form replaces former Class 1, 2 and 3 forms which are no longer acceptable. It dispenses with differences between adult and youth requirements. All forms now will be required ANNUALLY, for adults and youth alike. Parts A & C are required annually from

all registered Scouts for all activities. Part C is needed for activities lasting over 72 hours: resident camps, high adventure activities, strenuous activities (such as certain service projects) and work weekends. They must be completed by a licensed health care provider and requires compliance with a height-weight chart some may be familiar with from Philmont and other former high adventure medical forms. Starting in 2010 all medicals must be completed annually.

# National Youth Leadership Training - 2010

Erie Shores Council is sponsoring another 21st Century Course called NYLT (National Youth Leadership Training) and will be held at Camp Miakonda the week of **June 13-18, 2010.**

This NYLT course is set up to represent a month in the life of a typical Scout troop, mirroring the troop structure, by assigning incoming participants to patrols.
